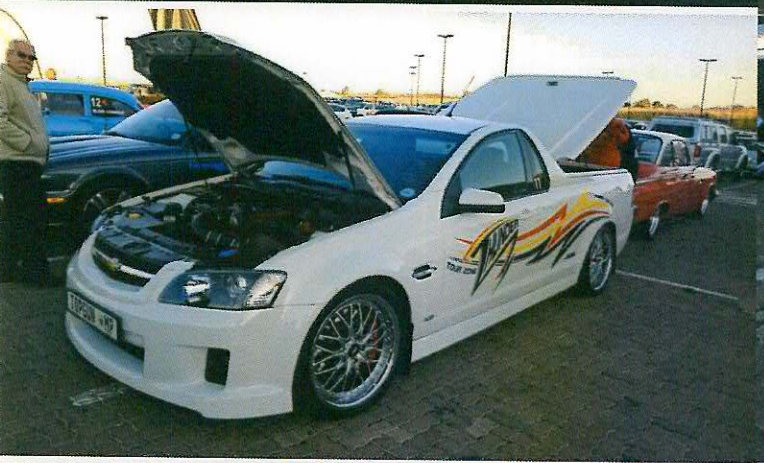

SAVVA Technical Tip 110 – home made tools

Most enthusiasts have at some time or the other “manufactured” a tool to suit their special needs.

Many years ago I had a set of sockets that had a particular tool in it which I used quite frequently. Unfortunately, the entire socket set disappeared one evening to what I believe is called “nocturnal shopping”.

Fortunately I was able to replace the set with a similar set of Gedore sockets – but without the particular tool that I used so often, which incidentally, was part of the original set. Unfortunately, they have discontinued this particular tool so I decided to make my own using an extension bar and bending the end at right angles.

As will be seen in the illustration, the bottom one is what is currently available. It has a receptacle at one end for an extension bar and a square at the other to take a socket – very handy, but every now and again I also need a bar that takes a socket at both ends like the top one in the picture.

I was fortunate to find an extension at a flea market that could take a socket at both ends, heated it up and bent the end 90 degrees.
